- **Briefing night Thursday 16th April**- You will be briefed on Competition Rules, Regulations, Fishing Bag Limits. Teams will be presented with Team goodies Bags & scoring sheets. Enjoy a few Beverages with a BBQ dinner and a chance to catch up with other teams.
- **Convoy Friday 17th April** yes we are departing for the wonderful Buccaneer Archipelago on Good Friday. All teams must launch no later than 7.45am. MIFC helpers will transport cars and trailers back to the club to be securely stored. This convoy is follow the leader with safety stops to ensure everyone is travelling together (approx. 4hrs) Expecting Highlights of Hells Gates, Whirlpool Passage, Silica Beach, Croc Creek and Silver gull to Name a few. Accommodation is also available on Cockatoo island at a cost, entry form has details. Access on and off the Island is attainable most of the time over the comp with only small time slots where there is not enough water to access the beach.
- **Fishing Grounds** – Yampi sound and surrounding islands and Creek systems are all on offer. Just try your luck.
- **Memorial Breakfast/Presentation, Monday 20th April** – Today we remember a mate and award the much sort after category awards while enjoying a full cooked breakfast at Buccaneer Beach on Gibbons Island.
